



Gettysburg Soup Kitchen Ministry: St Rita's will be sponsoring the Thursday, September 19th meal plus raising funds to procure food items for the Gettysburg Soup Kitchen. The Soup Kitchen continues to play a significant role in feeding a growing community of families and people in need - offering take-out meals Monday - Saturday (with a sack meal for Sunday), even on holidays. Meals provided over the summer averaged over 70 patrons/day. Contributions from our Parish include the main meat, sides, fruit and a simple dessert averaging about \$200 in today's food prices. We also will purchase needed food items such as bulk meats, frozen foods, fresh vegetables and fruits, and many other critical groceries to stock their freezers and pantries for future use. Financial contributions of Cash or checks made out to "Chris Manning" will be used to support the meal and to purchase groceries. Checks can also be made directly to the Gettysburg Community Soup Kitchen to support other needs. Chris Manning will be located outside each of the Masses to collect donations. Questions?
